Ligament reconstruction

- TFCC: - capsular repair
- fovea reattachment (inside-out and outside-in)
- Scaphoid-lunate ligament reconstruction

Resection procedures

- Radial styloid resection
- Arthroscopic Wafer procedure
- Arthroscopic ganglion excision

Basal joint surgery

- Hemitrapeziectomy
- Tissue interposition

Endoscopic cubital tunnel release

Lectures and demonstrations by the faculty, followed by arthroscopic surgery practice with supervision by the faculty. Anatomic specimens with full arthroscopic equipment and fluoroscan will be available per two participants. Dissection faculty consists of national faculty consisting of hand surgeons with an extensive experience in arthroscopy. Every two participants will be guided by 1 faculty member.
